Subject: Exhibition of Photographs by Sorin Alb

Title of exhibit: Of Trees and Humans

Displayed: May 1st to 31st, 2022

Location: The Daly Grind Café, 1680 Lakeshore Rd W, Unit 1, Mississauga,

Monday - Sunday 8:00 am - 4:00 pm

Brief Description: Humans destroy the environment with a dedication worthy of a better cause. This exhibition takes you through different stages of trees' destruction. Viewers see that the trees adapted and "embraced" the enemy until it was time for total annihilation, the leftovers of which are still visible today. Each print shows the coordinates of the location.

There will be a silent auction for each print, with updates sent to the bidders on every Sunday. The net proceeds (final price minus the price of materials) will all be donated to charities helping Ukrainian people and animals. Further information will be provided directly to the bidders. It is recommended to have a QR code reader installed on your phones to access the information faster at the exhibition.

About the author: Sorin caught the photography "virus" in late 70s. He tried to get a "cure" by walking through the woods with his dog, using his eyes as the camera and his brain as the film, turned sensor, later. He gave up fighting the "virus" in 1985 when he joined the University Photo-Club from Cluj-Napoca, Romania. He is a self-taught photographer that enjoys a variety of subjects. This exhibition is a modest attempt at trying to slow the "slaughter" of trees around us and to make the viewers reflect on what really matters in their lives and to appreciate what they have.

Dr. Kah-Wai Lin is a professional landscape photographer based in New Jersey. He is the Goodwill Ambassador and former Chapter, Clubs and Councils Vice President of Photographic Society of America (PSA). Dr. Lin is the official photographer of Phase One Camera, director of Global Elite Photographer, ambassador & education advisor of NiSi, ambassador & global marketing advisor of Fotopro, ambassador & global marketing advisor of Feiyu, pro team of Spiffy Gear, ambassador & international liaison officer of Studio of Masters, and panda ambassador, World Wildlife Fund (WWF). He also operates a camera & telescope store, Stetinden Photo, in New Jersey. Over the past few years, he has been presenting over 200 seminars worldwide, and has received over 200 awards in photographic contests. Notably, he is the recipient of Certificate of Special Congressional Recognition from US Member of Congress. In his presentation, Dr. Kah-Wai Lin will tell you the pro tips in seeing the unseen and crafting better images in landscape photography: how to use the lights to create visual emotion; how to use long exposure to create visual dynamism; how to use field of vision to create visual perspective; and how to use composition to create visual continuity and story.
